# **RC Forward 2023 Year In Review**

2023 presented significant challenges for RC Forward and our team. As <u>we shared</u> in July, the unexpected cessation of our previous grant facilitator prompted a comprehensive review of our operations. This review highlighted several changes necessary to ensure we strengthen our partnership approach as a Canadian registered charity.

We are incredibly grateful to our donor community for their patience, feedback, and trust. Despite these challenges, you contributed nearly \$4 million in 2023 to high-impact projects, reaching a total of \$24 million in all-time gifts.

Our charity partners also deserve special recognition. They were affected by our operational changes, and we appreciated the opportunity to work individually with each partner to help them stay connected to their Canadian supporters. Their understanding and patience has been invaluable.



### **Donation overview**


#### Annual donations over time

In 2023 donations totalled \$3,940,091. RC Forward was launched in late 2017, and 6 years later we surpassed \$24 million in all-time donations!




### Causes supported in 2023

RC Forward donors support several causes. As in past years, our most popular causes by donation totals are global health, animal welfare, and human empowerment. Causes supported were also significantly influenced by the July 2023 pause in new donations for 3 of our Funds: Human Empowerment, Climate Change, and Long-Term Future.



### **Project versus Fund**



All recommendations in 2023 were heavily influenced by RC Forward's need to pause new donations for most projects in July; new donations were mainly limited to global health, human empowerment, and animal welfare causes.

# Gift direction update for 2023 gifts





RC Forward is a project of Rethink Charity. Its team and operations support multiple projects; RC Forward's revenue and expenses are estimated below.








### **Support for RC Forward**

Siobhan remains on the Rethink Charity Foundation Board and we are deeply grateful for her contributions since RC Forward's inception! Megan and SK were able to visit Siobhan on the Sunshine Coast to have a farewell meal, and the former two tacked-on a mini retreat to take advantage of being in the same place.





Megan and SK adjusted to working as a two-person team, trying on different combinations of roles. For much of the year, they worked as Co-Executive Directors, each holding significant responsibility for the organization's operation and stakeholders.

Megan and SK had the opportunity to travel to London for EA Global 2023. The focus of their conversations there were the changes taking place at RC Forward. Through these changes the broader EA and effective giving communities have been a steady source of inspiration, support, and useful feedback.
